

# 2017-2018 CCA FINANCIAL INFORMATION

## MATRICULATION FEES

**MATRICULATION FEES** are one way the school covers its operating costs. Fees are one of the fairest ways of doing this inasmuch as each parent is charged only for the services they actually receive, services such as band, computer lab, or lockers. **Totals below include:** Supplemental accident insurance (\$10.00 or \$25) and School accreditation fees (\$28.00). **In addition, where applicable:** Iowa Achievement Test \$25; CogAT (Cognitive Ability Test) \$25; PEERS, \$25; Library, \$15; Biology, \$30; Chemistry, \$30; Physics, \$30; Computer Lab, \$30; Locker, \$20; Typing, \$30; Activities, \$30; Technology Fee, \$20; Physical Education, \$15; RenWeb \$45; Elem. Instrument fee, \$10; Fine Arts Course Fee, \$30; Music, \$15; Band, \$100; Band Instrument Rental, \$10 month; Yearbook optional.

**TOTAL MATRICULATION FEES BY GRADE:** K2, \$37; K3, \$62; K4, \$117; K5, \$262; G1, \$332; G2, \$332; G3, \$342; G4, \$367; G5, \$432; G6, \$432; G7, \$282; G8, \$282; G9, \$307; G10, \$307; G11, \$337; G12, \$832 (Grade 12 fees include graduation and senior trip. One half {\$416.00} is due at beginning of school and the other half {\$416.00} February 1.) *(For a \$3.00 monthly charge, matriculation fees may be divided into ten equal monthly payments and paid with tuition.)* (Matriculation Fees are recalculated each summer)

## HOUSEHOLD DISCOUNTS FOR K3 – G12

15% on second child, 20% on third child, 25% on fourth. Charges are figured on highest rate first, etc.

\* To drop off as early as 7:00 or stay until 5:30, see Childcare Services below.

\*\* PARTIAL MONTHS. After Sept. 15, in K3 and above, partial months are figured at \$25 per day for school days remaining in the month. After Sept. 15, for age 2 and below, the rate is \$30.00 per day. Regular tuition applies after partial month.

A 2% discount is given for paying up-front in cash. A 2% surcharge is made when using a charge card.



## CHILDCARE SERVICES

Before School (7:00 – 7:40)	\$2.00 a day or \$30.00 per month
After School (3:20 – 5:30)	\$6.00 a day or \$80.00 per month
Both Before & After School Care	\$100.00 per month

## SCHOLARSHIPS

A \$250 scholarship will be awarded for each new student referred by a current parent or student. New parents must tell office at time of enrollment who referred them and must remain full year. Scholarship is applied to a parent's final bill for the year. This could grow to \$1,000, \$2,000 – no limit.

Special needs students may apply for a SC scholarship. These scholarships can be up to \$12,000 per student. CCA is an approved school for these scholarships. In addition, SC will reimburse parents up to \$12,000 for tuition paid to CCA for a special needs student.

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

Fees are designed to be paid in full before school begins. However, for an additional charge of \$3.00 per month, fees may be paid in ten equal monthly payments. Tuition may be paid in full up-front, one half each semester or in 10 payments. **A 2% discount is given for paying up-front for the year in cash. A 2% surcharge is made when using a charge card.** If the ten-payment plan is chosen, payments are due monthly on the first of the month beginning with August and ending with May.

## FINANCIAL TERMS

1. Late charges of \$20.00 will be added on the 10th and an additional charge of \$20.00 on the 20<sup>th</sup> if the amount due is not paid in full. Students are not permitted to continue if accounts are not current at month's end. Grades and transcripts will be withheld until accounts are paid in full.
2. All kindergarten accounts must be current by Dec.10th for student to return on Dec. 11th.
3. All kindergarten accounts must be paid in full by May 2<sup>nd</sup> for student to return on May 3<sup>rd</sup>.
4. Accounts in G1-12 must be paid in full by May 10<sup>th</sup> for student to return on May 11<sup>th</sup>.
5. If a student is withdrawn before year's end, there will be a \$50 early withdrawal charge.

Elective Band: \$20.00 per month

## TUTORING AND IEP'S

For students who need it, CCA can arrange one on one tutoring and other intervention measures. The charges for these services may vary from student to student but will be commensurate with the services provided.

## ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION FEES

Volleyball, Basketball, J.V. and Varsity Cheerleading, \$65 per each. Golf, \$75.

## BOOKS

Textbooks, workbooks, and other books are provided for students at no additional charge. These materials remain the property of CCA. If a student withdraws, books and related materials remain with school. Yearbooks are purchased separately.

## CHECKS

Checks may be deposited the day received. \$35.00 will be charged for returned checks. After two returned checks in a school year, no additional checks will be accepted.

## SUMMER SCHOOL

Registration plus one-half tuition due before 1<sup>st</sup> day of class and balance 30 days later.

Registration: \$30 per subject  
Tuition: \$325 for makeup subjects; \$600 for new subjects  
Books: Book cost will vary with subject

## CHRISTIAN COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

Carolina Christian Academy will award a tuition scholarship to each of its graduates who attend a Christian college that is an affiliate of the American Association of Christian Schools and Colleges, the association to which CCA belongs. Some of these colleges are: Bob Jones, Pensacola, Clearwater, Piedmont, Crown, and Ambassador. The amount of the scholarship shall consist of \$200 for each year continuously enrolled at the time of graduation. This could easily exceed \$3,000. It will be spread out evenly over four years and paid directly to the college. Students must carry a full load and maintain at least a 2.5 average.
