ENROLLMENT FEES

New enrollment: Before July 15th, \$75; After July 15th, \$100.

Re-enrollment: Before May 1st, \$50; May 1st - July 15th, \$75; After July 15th, \$100.

(Refundable only if the school declines application)

MATRICULATION FEES

MATRICULATION FEES are one way the school covers its operating costs. Fees are one of the fairest ways of doing this inasmuch as each parent is charged only for the services they actually receive, services such as band, computer lab, or lockers. **Totals below include:** Supplemental accident insurance (\$17.00) and annual accreditation fees (\$26.00). **In addition, where applicable:** SAT-10, \$19; OLSAT, \$19; PLAN, \$21; PSAT, \$16; PEERS, \$15; Library, \$15; Biology, \$30; Chemistry, \$30; Physics, \$30; Computer Lab, \$30; Locker, \$20; Typing, \$30; Activity, \$25; Technology Fee, \$15; Physical Education, \$15; Information Direct, \$19; Instrument fee, \$8; Fine Arts Course Fee, \$30; Music, \$15; and Band, \$100. Yearbook optional.

TOTAL MATRICULATION FEES BY GRADE: K5, \$100; G1, \$277; G2, \$277; G3, \$287; G4, \$292; G5, \$352; G6, \$352; G7, \$262; G8, \$262; G9, \$339; G10, \$339; G11, \$339; G12, \$787 (Grade 12 fees include graduation and senior trip. One half {\$384.50} is due at beginning of school and other half {\$384.50} February 1.) *(For a \$2.75 monthly charge, matriculation fees may be divided into ten equal monthly payments and paid with tuition.)* (Matriculation Fees are recalculated each summer for following year)

SCHOLARSHIPS

A \$250 scholarship will be awarded for each new student referred by a current parent or student. New parents must tell office at time of enrollment who referred them and must remain full year. Scholarship is applied to a parent's final bill for the year. This could grow to \$1,000, \$2,000 – no limit.

BOOKS

Textbooks, workbooks, and other books are provided for students at no additional charge. These materials remain the property of CCA. If a student withdraws, books and related materials remain with school. Yearbooks are purchased separately.

CHECKS

Checks may be deposited the day received. \$35.00 will be charged for returned checks. After two returned checks in a school year, no additional checks will be accepted.

SUMMER SCHOOL

Registration plus one-half tuition due before 1st day of class and balance 30 days later.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Fees are designed to be paid in full before school begins. However, for an additional charge of \$2.75 per month, fees may be paid in ten equal monthly payments. Tuition may be paid in full up-front, one half each semester or in 10 payments. A 2% discount is given for paying up-front in cash. If the ten payment plan is chosen, payments are due monthly on the first of the month beginning with August and ending with May.

FINANCIAL TERMS

1. Late charges of \$20.00 will be added on the 10th and an additional charge of \$20.00 on the 20th if the amount due is not paid in full. Students are not permitted to continue if accounts are not current at month's end. Grades and transcripts will be withheld until accounts are paid in full.
2. All kindergarten accounts must be current by Dec.10th for student to return on Dec. 11th.
3. All kindergarten accounts must be paid in full by May 2nd for student to return on May 3rd.
4. Accounts in G1-12 must be paid in full by May 10th for student to return on May 11th.
5. If a student is withdrawn before year's end, there will be a \$50 early withdrawal charge. Students enrolled less than 180 days are charged tuition for the number of days enrolled. Daily rate is annual tuition divided by 180. Prepaid tuition minus these amounts will be refunded.

CHRISTIAN COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

Carolina Christian Academy will award a tuition scholarship to each of its graduates who attend a Christian college that is an affiliate of the American Association of Christian Schools and Colleges, the association to which CCA belongs. Some of these colleges are: Bob Jones, Pensacola, Clearwater, Piedmont, Crown, and Ambassador. The amount of the scholarship shall consist of \$200 for each year continuously enrolled at the time of graduation. This could easily exceed \$3,000. It will be spread out evenly over four years and paid directly to the college. Students must carry a full load and maintain at least a 2.5 average.
